

Mystery Leak by Jim Walker


- Mid-Sept- Losing water- Cabin leak leaked out 10,000 gallons
- Oct- Rural Water Help 2 men, 3 digs on Turkey Track Dry- American Leak Detection on CO well house 3 noise. Exec Dir, Conner said they
 were not able to find leak.
- Nov-Cabin #8 Dig Dry- Rural Water back out, Fire Hydrant Leak Falls Creek, Falls Creek Dig Dry
- Winter set in- No storage, Resume search in Spring
- Kept water in lines throughout winter as long as power was on
- File Construction to pot hole asap using vacuum truck-Levi's request
- 10 gpm leak at 27 bear Lane- repaired
- Well House 3 still suspect- rebuild- Grant Application for \$150K with engineering services was unsuccessful- Will need to raise rates and get a
 new loan per DFA, do an assessment, or all three (3)
- 4/27 RWA sent out another resources to assist Levi
- 5/11 Major Main Leak near Wright Cabin- dug and closed no leak found-may resurface with head pressure
- 5/14 Upper Tank Main Leak 10-15gpm-Had to bring in File Construction with heavy equipment to repair- Fixed













Supplemental Water by David Oelschlegel

- Water tanker last fall 6200 gallons- Underutilized No longer available- only 10% used -CABQ said no on future use
- RAC Water Bottles placed at Fire station- 2 pallets
- RAC provided no additional water after numerous requests
- Rain for Rent- >\$5,000 per month-Cost Prohibitive
- City came through after numerous calls-Tanker is Back!
- 3rd Tanker load delivered on 5/18

- Handle OSE Objections-Past Well 1a Bogus Sites-and No Permit since 2009-Emergency Authorization
- Create Affidavit for Clearing of Bogus Well 1a Well Sites
- Manage Draws on Contractor Charges
- Advertise New Well Rio Grande Sun
- Complete in Spring or early Summer
- NORA power poles have been placed- getting ready for line run















Audits and 40 Year Water Plan by Jay Mason & David O

- Currently 48 af on file- Board Approved- OSE wants to take it to 17.2 – We should fight this.

NORA POWER by David Oelschlegel

- Line run from base of Falls Creek Rd to Upper tank
- Original path was unsuccessful due to easement issues
- Secondary path involved 3 land owners- all approved and recorded
- Took about 2 years for entire project
- NORA's been paid in full and Line is in and in production
- Tree Clearing \$10,000- 3 Board Members did it for free

RATE CHANGE by Marco Lucero

- Last rate change was in 2004 18 years ago
