Recommended Cabin Water Shut-Down Procedures

Summer (15 minutes for typical house)

- 1. Turn off water at stop and waste valve
- 2. Open a faucet to ensure stop and waste valve has shut off entirely
- 3. Turn off gas or electric to water heater
- 3. Make sure you return before winter freeze to complete winter shut-down

Winter (30 minutes for typical house)

- 1. Turn off water at stop and waste valve
- 2. Open all inside and outside faucets
- 3. Fully drain toilet tank and bowl
- 4. Place RV-type antifreeze in toilet bowl sufficient to flood P-trap
- 5. Place RV-type antifreeze in all p-traps in sinks, tubs, showers

Tank-type water heaters

- 6. Open pressure release valve on top of water heater
- 7. Fully drain water heater with garden hose

Tankless Water heaters

Drain following specific manufacturer's instructions

^{*}Thorough draining of low spots in lines may require additional drain valves, blowing out with compressed air, etc.
